The call for papers is now open for submissions on all topics related to Environmental and Natural Resource Economics. **The deadline for paper submissions has been extended until March 31, 2026.** Theoretical and empirical papers, in a reasonably advanced stage, are welcome and can be submitted [here](#). Young researchers and PhD students are especially encouraged to submit. AERNA will offer a limited number of travel grants for doctoral students.

All submissions will undergo a standard peer-review process. Authors will be notified of **acceptance decisions by April 30, 2026.**

Environmental economics, natural resource economics, sustainability, climate change, energy transitions, circular economy, water-energy-food nexus, public policy, and research on efficient resource management, covering areas like electricity markets or decarbonization.
